This position performs specialized duties to include processing/evaluating 911-calls and other emergency and non-emergency requests for Police, Fire, and medical assistance; dispatching and monitoring emergency public safety units. This is the journey level in the 911/Public Safety Dispatcher series.

THE AGENCY

The Yolo Emergency Communications Agency (Yolo 911) was established in 1988 to provide public safety dispatch services for Police, Fire, Animal Control, Public Works, and other local government functions, serving the County Sheriff, 3 City Police Departments, and 17 Fire Agencies.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

Ability to react quickly, efficiently, and calmly in an emergency situation; speak and write clearly and concisely; memorize and recall names and locations of highways, streets, and buildings; deal effectively and tactfully with public safety personnel and general public.

REQUIREMENTS

This is an entry level position requiring the ability to type 35 words per minute; equivalent to graduation from high school. Willingness and ability to work any shift in a 24-hour period, holidays, and weekends.
